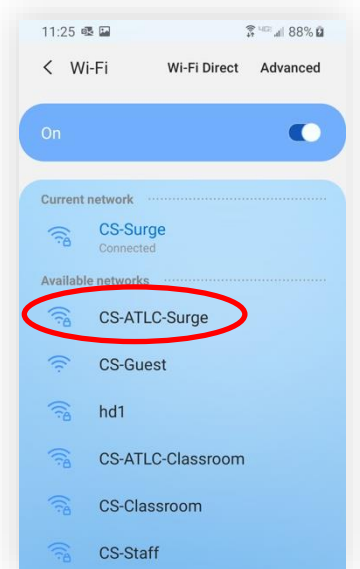


Personal device connecting to wifi Networks – Android

Students and employees who want to use their personal mobile devices will need to logon to the wireless network and accept terms before gaining access to the network.

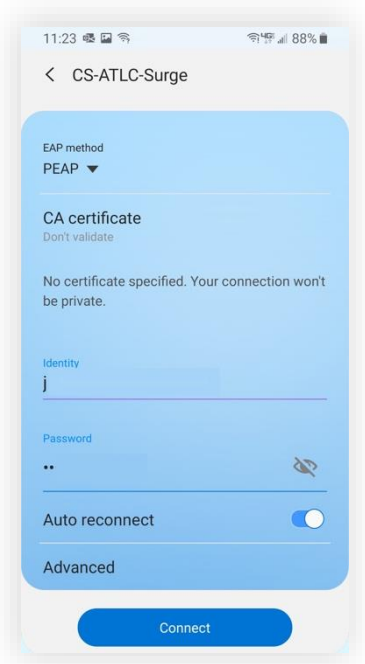
Android Devices will look vary in appearance depending on hardware, Android version, and carriers. This is a general guide for connecting on Android based devices.

1. To connect to a wifi network, go to your Settings. Then select Wireless and Networks or Wifi.
2. As long as your wifi is on, you'll see a list of available networks. Select the network with Surge in the name. The Surge networks are for the personal devices of employees and students with network accounts.



3. When you click on the network, you'll be presented with a dialog box to join.

- In the drop-down menu below "EAP method" Select PEAP.
- Under "CA certificate", Don't Validate should be selected.
- Enter you CState username as your Identity, and your CState password as your password.
- Click on Connect.



4. After connecting, you will be asked to agree to the terms. Click on Continue to the Internet to fully connect.
