

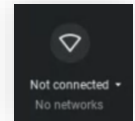
Personal device connecting to wifi Networks – Chromebook

Students and employees who want to use their personal mobile devices will need to logon to the wireless network and accept terms before gaining access to the network.

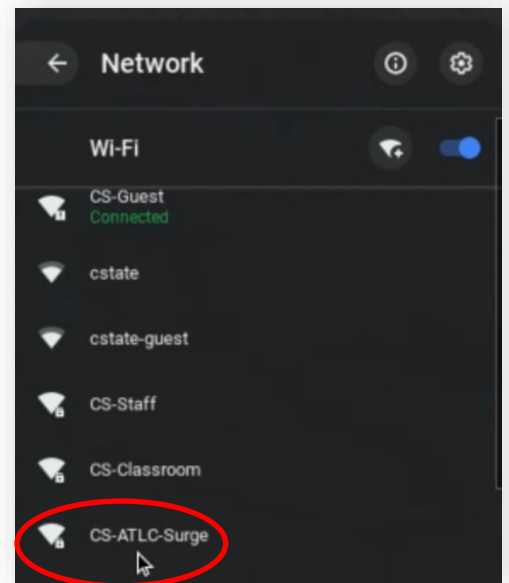
1. To find a network near you, click on the Status Area. The Status Area is in the lower right corner of your screen.



2. A Menu with various settings will pop up. Look for the Wifi icon and click on it.



3. A list of networks will pop up. Click on the network with Surge in the name. These networks are for both employee and student personal devices.



4. When you click on the network, you'll be presented with a dialog box to join..

- In the drop-down menu below "EAP method" Select PEAP.
- Leave the next box on Automatic.
- Under "Server CA certificate", Do not check should be selected.

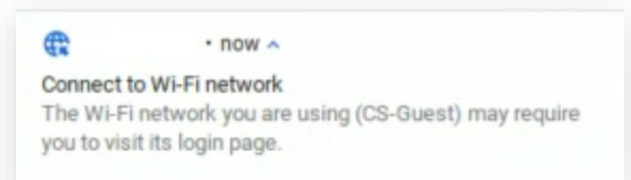
