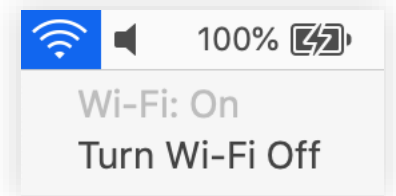


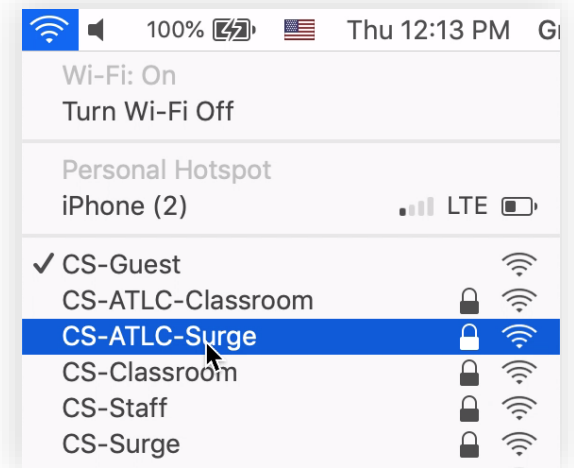
Personal device connecting to wifi Networks – macOS

Students and employees who want to use their personal mobile devices will need to logon to the wireless network and accept terms before gaining access to the network.

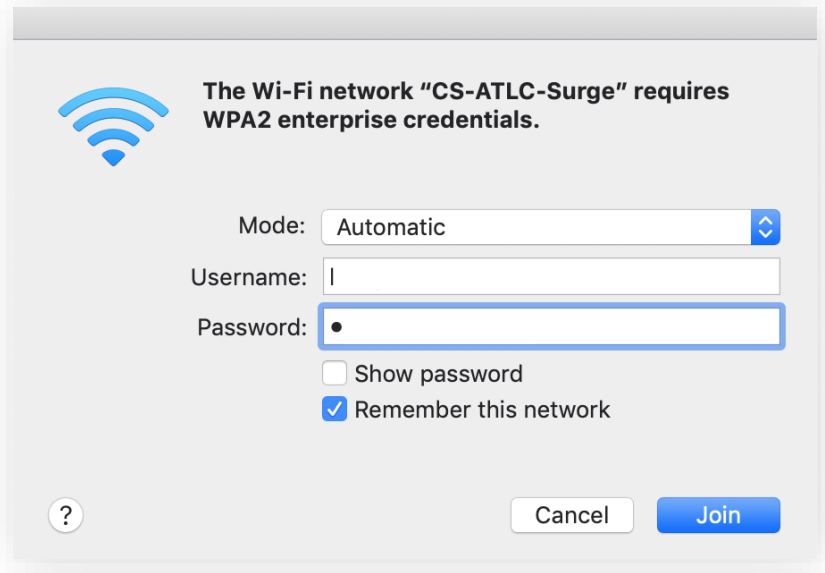
1. To find a network near you, click on the wifi icon in your status menus. The status menus are at the right side of the top of your screen. Sometimes you have to move your mouse to the top of the screen to see them.



2. When you click on the icon, you'll see a list of available networks. Select the network with Surge in the name. The Surge networks are for student and employee personal devices. Click on the name of the network you wish to join.



- When you click on connect, your computer will check the network requirements. Then, you'll be asked to enter your username and password. This will be the same information you use to sign into Blackboard or MyCState.



- You must agree to the terms before you can access the internet. This window should pop in in your default browser when you connect. Click on Continue to the Internet.
