

Cincinnati State Wifi Networks

Overview

This document will give an overview of the new wifi networks and instructions for connecting to these networks. The college has upgraded wifi at the following locations.

- Clifton Campus
 - ATLC (Advanced Learning and Technology Center)
 - HPB (Health Professions Building)
- Evendale Campus
- Harrison Campus
- OT (Occupational Therapy) House

The upgrade in these locations are part of Phase 1 of the Wifi Upgrade Project. Wifi in the Main building on the Clifton campus and the Middletown campus have not been upgraded but plans are underway.

Instructions

Wifi networks that end with **Surge** are for students and employees to use on their personally owned devices. The **Surge** wifi networks allow access to more resources than the **Guest** networks. Guest networks are intended for visitors who don't have a college network account.

Important to Note: The two most common ways to resolve connection issues are:

1. Turn wifi off and then turn it back on
2. "Forget" a wifi network; this will remove the settings and allow your device to get new settings

Students and Employees

Guests of the college should use the **Guest** wifi networks. These are visitors who don't have an active college network account.

Wifi Networks

The locations that have been upgraded have four new wifi networks.

- **Surge:** Wifi networks for students and employees using their personally owned devices; logon required
 - CS-ATLC-**Surge**
 - CS-HPB-**Surge**
 - CS-**Surge** (Evendale, Harrison, OT House)
- **Guest:** Wifi networks for visitors who do not have a college network account; limited internet access
 - CS-ATLC-**Guest**
 - CS-HPB-**Guest**
 - CS-**Guest** (Evendale, Harrison)
- **Staff:** Wifi networks for college-owned devices (laptops, Surfaces, iPads, etc.)
 - CS-ATLC-**Staff**
 - CS-HPB-**Staff**
 - CS-**Staff** (Evendale, Harrison, OT House)
- **Classroom:** Wifi networks for college-owned classroom laptops
 - CS-ATLC-**Classroom**
 - CS-HPB-**Classroom**
 - CS-**Classroom** (Evendale, Harrison, OT House)

Surge

The following are wifi networks for students and employees using their personally owned devices.

- CS-ATLC-**Surge**
- CS-HPB-**Surge**
- CS-**Surge** (Evendale, Harrison)

Users will be required to accept the terms and conditions of the college's [Acceptable Use of Technology Policy](#) before gaining access to these networks. An active student or employee logon is required.

Guest

The following are wifi networks for guests of the college. These are visitors who don't have a college network account.

- **CS-ATLC-Guest**
- **CS-HPB-Guest**
- **CS-Guest** (Evendale, Harrison)

These networks have limited internet access along with content filtering. Gaming is an example of content not permitted on the guest networks.

Users will also be required to accept the terms and conditions of the college's [Acceptable Use of Technology Policy](#) before gaining access to these networks.

Staff

The following are wifi networks for college-owned devices (laptops, Surfaces, iPads, etc.).

The [MAC](#) address of devices that connect to these networks must be registered with ITS. An active employee logon is required.

Classroom

The following are wifi networks for college-owned classroom laptops.

- **CS-ATLC-Classroom**
- **CS-HPB-Classroom**
- **CS-Classroom** (Evendale, Harrison, OT House)

These are usually the laptops within charging carts. The [MAC](#) address of devices that connect to these networks must be registered with ITS. An active employee logon is required.

Main Building

There are no changes to connecting to wifi in the Main building on the Clifton campus. The following are the wireless networks for the Main building. The Main building will be upgraded in Phase 2 of the Wifi Upgrade Project.

cstate-staff

This wireless network is for college-owned devices (laptops, Surfaces, iPads, etc.). The [MAC](#) address of devices that connect to these networks must be registered with ITS. An active employee logon is required.

cstate-student

This wireless network is for college-owned classroom laptops. These are usually the laptops within charging carts. The [MAC](#) address of devices that connect to these networks must be registered with ITS. An active student or employee logon is required.

cstate

This wireless network is for guests of the college. This network has limited internet access along with content filtering.

Middletown

There are no changes to connecting to wifi on the Middletown campus. The following are the wireless networks at Middletown.

cstate-staff

This wireless network is for college-owned devices (laptops, Surfaces, iPads, etc.). The [MAC](#) address of devices that connect to these networks must be registered with ITS. An active employee logon is required.

cstate-student

This wireless network is for college-owned classroom laptops. These are usually the laptops within charging carts. The [MAC](#) address of devices that connect to these networks must be registered with ITS. An active student or employee logon is required.

cstate

This wireless network is for guests of the college. This network has limited internet access along with content filtering.
